Wavell Community Primary School recognises that it's pupils, visitors and staff, whether disabled or otherwise, have individual needs when seeking to make use of the school and facilities. However, at Wavell Community Primary School we also recognise the fact that for some users, the nature of their disabilities may mean that they experience specific difficulties related to accessing education at the school, and the physical environment. As part of our ongoing commitment to Equal Opportunities and the delivery of an inclusive educational service, we will endeavour to ensure that disabled people receive the same standards of service as everyone else.

In the light of this the Governors & Senior Management Team will communicate to all staff that our policy for the provision of educational services ensures the complete inclusion of disabled people.

Staff will be given appropriate disability awareness training, which will explain the policy of the school towards disabled users and the effective implementation of access improvements.

Governors and Staff will address acts of disability discrimination via existing conduct codes, where appropriate.

Governors & Staff will encourage suppliers & contractors, to adopt similar policies toward disabled people.

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In order to ensure that the services it provides effectively meet the needs of disabled customers, Staff at Wavell Community Primary School will:

- consult with disabled pupils, parents, staff and disability organisations
- regularly review whether its education and community services are both accessible and effective, and take appropriate action
- monitor the implementation and effectiveness of this policy on a regular basis
- operate an accessibility complaints procedure whereby disabled people can make improvement suggestions and request assistance

Strategy

Wavell Community Primary School has prioritised the actions to be taken to achieve full access for pupils and adults with a wide range of disabilities as the following:

1. Provide appropriate training for staff. Should pupils or staff with specific disabilities join the school staff will undertake additional training.

However, if pupils or staff join the school with specific disabilities currently rated as a lower priority we will address those needs as a matter of urgency.
